Entrepreneurship Program at IISc

Bangalore Chapter of IISc Alumni Association initiated a project in July 2010, to study the current situation and recommend a suitable Entrepreneurship Program in the context of IISc and is students' centric. An Alumni team, which has experience in creating and growing successful technology companies and entrepreneurs within a corporate environment, was formed for the study. The team was led by Mr Anand Talwai, Chairman of Bangalore Chapter and supported by other executive committee members Mr Vishnu Makkapati, Dr Sanjay Chitnis, Suman Devadula and Mr Uday Shankar.

The team started interacting with SID on one side and Alumni Cell on the other side to have an idea of current entrepreneurship activity at IISc. Alumni cell informed the study team about it and connected them to 'Swayam', run by Student Council since 2009. It also connected them to Parjanya portal coordinator, Mr Amogha. Swayam is a student run platform at IISc to create the spirit of enterprise creation among Science and Technology students of IISc. Alumni cell was already helping the Swayam group by connecting them to alumni from abroad such as Dr Parveen Jain, USA, Prof Yogesh Gianchandani of University of Michigan and

Dr Murthy Halemane of Netherlands, who have become successful entrepreneurs. Their lectures were organized and some of them exposed students to similar ongoing programs in their universities and shared with them syllabus of the courses. The study team also interacted with successful entrepreneurs and intrapreneurs in corporates and also studied similar programs in top US and India Universities. It also interacted with Department of Management studies and some faculty-entrepreneurs in IISc.

The Study consisted of following major components:

- Interaction with students interested in Entrepreneurship to understand their requirements. It was a half-a-day program; huge and positive response interviews with faculty who had supported entrepreneurship in one form or the other.
- Interaction with large number of alumni in Bangalore and USA who are successful entrepreneurs. Inputs from personal experiences of study team members.
- Discussions with Prof Mohan, Chairman, Alumni Cell and Student Council members.
- Comparison of similar programs in IITs, IIMs, MIT, Stanford and other leading universities.
- Discussions with Profs Veni Madhavan, Mary Mathew and Bala Subrahmanya. Review of all existing companies in SID by a panel of alumni consisting of Dr Gopalkrishna, Mr D.N. Prahlad and Dr C.V. Natraj.
- Based on the study, an Entrepreneurship Program in the context of IISc was recommended.

The study was completed in December 2010. The study report along with recommendations was presented to Prof P. Balaram, Director, IISc by Mr Anand Talwai, Mr Vishnu Makkapati and Prof Mohan. Director was happy with the study and gave a positive response for its implementation. During January, February and March of 2011, detailed discussions were held particularly with SID, Department of Management studies, Prof Mohan and some active alumni. Discussions were also held with current incubate companies in SID.

Prof. N. Appaji Rao Best Mentor Award - 2011

(Instituted by students and associates of Prof. N. Appaji Rao)

The Indian Institute of Science Alumni Association invites nominations for the Prof. N. Appaji Rao Best Mentor Award. The purpose of the award is to honour a distinguished scientist in the area of Biological Sciences who has mentored several young persons to achieve positions of eminence and leadership.

- 1. Name of the Award : Prof. N. Appaji Rao Best Mentor Award
- 2. Eligibility: The awardee should be a distinguished academic or a leader in industrial research related to Biological Sciences; should have mentored associates, who have achieved leadership positions. The nominee should be below 65 years as on January 1, 2011.
- 3. The award consists of a cash prize of approx. Rs.1,00,000/- (inclusive of travel and incidental expenses) and a citation, which will be presented by the Director of IISc, Bangalore, India, on August 6, 2011. This award will be given once in 3 years starting from the year 2011.

The Department of Electrical Engineering, IISc Celebrates its Centenary during 2011-12

The department of Electrical Engineering at Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, completes one hundred years by summer of 2011. It was started as the department of Electrotechniques in 1911 and ten students were admitted for doing research in that year. The name of the department was changed to Electrical Technology in 1913. It became department of Electrical Engineering in 1963. During the early part of last century, this department was among the very few places in India where frontline research work was being carried out in the then emerging area of electrical engineering. Over the last one hundred years, this department has played a very significant role in promoting research and education in the area of Electrical Engineering in India. This department was instrumental in the formation of many departments at IISc and national laboratories such as CPRI. The alumni of this department have held prominent positions in academic institutions, research laboratories and government organizations both in India and abroad.

A number of events are planned during 2011-12 to celebrate the centenary of the department. These include a series of centenary talks by distinguished alumni of the department and other senior scientists and a series of special workshops including some continuing education workshops. A major event of the centenary celebrations is an international conference to be held at IISc during 15-17 December 2011. The conference will have plenary talks, invited talks and contributed paper presentations discussing current research issues in the areas of Power Systems, Power Electronics, High Voltage Engineering, Signal Processing, Image and Video Processing, Pattern Recognition and other related areas. There will also be one day of pre-conference tutorials. Immediately following the conference there would be a get-together of the alumni of the department for which all alumni are invited. It is an initiative started by a group of researchers of IISc in 2002 with the objective of supporting the education of underprivileged kids. The group began with supporting a single school in IISc, but today the activities span over 26 schools covering 4 districts in and around Bangalore. Also, recently, two of the IISc alumni, who were associated with NBD, have started similar activities in Kurukshetra (Haryana) and Pune (Maharashtra).

The earliest and the core activity of the group has been distribution of notebooks and stationary to the kids. With time, new initiatives like provision of library and sports facilities, organizing science fairs and education trips, giving scholarships to meritorious students, mentoring students, etc. have been added. All these aim to improve the overall quality of education in these rural government schools. Over nine years, Notebook drive has gained an unprecedented support and respect from the campus community. We request the alumni community to spread the idea of NBD themselves or help us by volunteering or by monetary support.

This group is a modest effort to transform students from literate to educated youth. The efforts, however little these may be if made consistently over a span of years, do make a difference. All we need is the constant support, enthusiasm and working hands: the vision that Swami Vivekananda had can indeed be a reality.
